Prone ultra-mini PCNL

Introduction: Miniaturization continues in percutaneous renal surgery. Recently, the Ultra-Mini PCNL with F12-14 shaft diameter has been introduced and so far reported favourably in the literature.

Material and Methods: This video will show a step-by-step approach to Ultra-Mini PCNL (UMP) in the classical prone position.

Conclusion: UMP is not only feasible but also safe and efficient in small to medium stones. In the prone position, the urologist will combine his skills acquired from PCNL and flexible URS with laser.
